



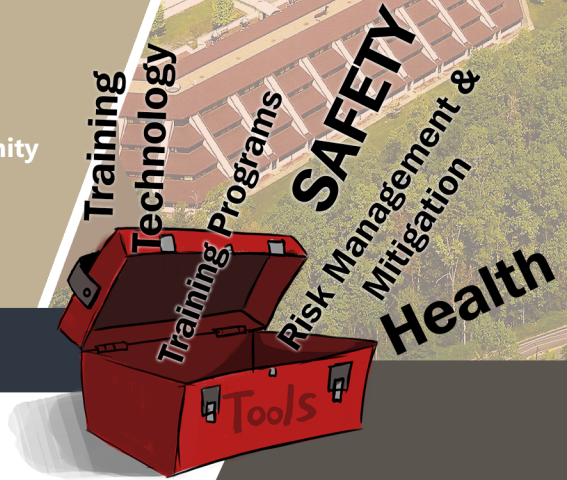

TRAINING MATERIALS COMPETITION

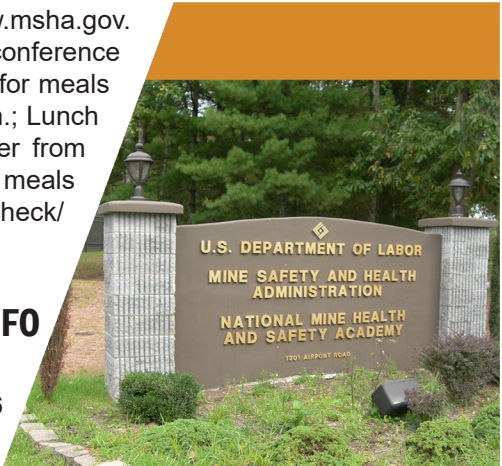
